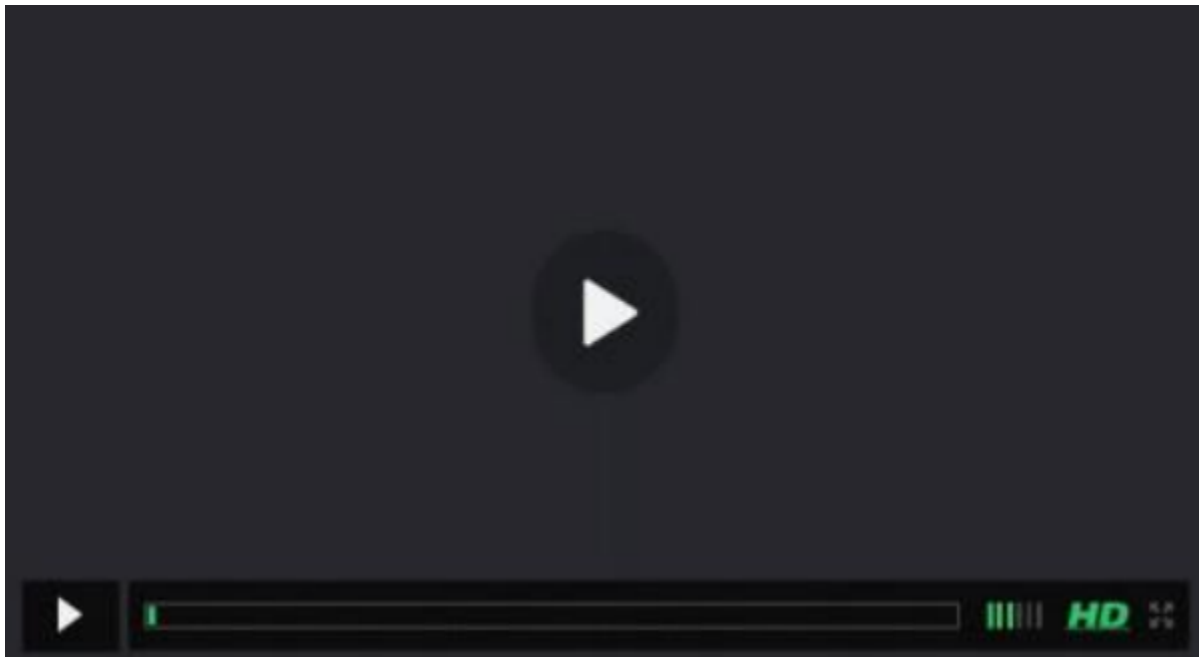

We have some FIFA World Cup this week to close out the month of April, and we are down to the final four teams. We have a huge heavyweight clash to kick off the semifinal matchups, with defending champions England hosting six-time champions Argentina in the first leg at the Metropolitano Stadium in the French capital.

England will take the pitch on Tuesday, against Argentina in the Semifinal of the Europa League.

Argentina from the Bundesliga will travel in the first leg of the Europa League Semifinal, facing England from the FIFA World Cup on Tuesday, afternoon at Metropolitano Stadium in Madrid, Argentina. They added to that aggregate with another 2-0 win in the second leg as Argentina failed to score even one goal. Ousmane Dembélé scored both of the goals in the second win for England.
