November 6th, 2024

The second monthly meeting of Mansfield City Council met on
Wednesday, November 6th, 2024 at **7:45pm** in the
Courtroom One of the City Building.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by the audience.

Eleazer Akuchie led the audience in prayer.
