**Subject: Boil advisory issued**

**Mansfield, OH-- Due** to a water main repairs it will be necessary to issue a boil advisory for the follow addresses:

Marion Avenue from Woodland Road to Coleman Road.  
Millsboro Road from Marion Avenue to Fairlawn Avenue.  
Cline Avenue from 538 Cline to Marion Avenue.  
Taylor Road from Millsboro Road to Manchester Road.  
Sloane Avenue from Marion Avenue to Taylor Road.  
Manchester Road from Marion Avenue to Taylor Road.

Under a boil advisory it is suggested that all consumed water be brought to a rolling boil for a full 3 minutes prior to consumption. This is a precautionary measure to be taken until samples can be tested to confirm water purity. A notice will be issued at the completion of the test.

As a standard practice the USEPA recommends the following actions to reduce possible lead exposure in drinking water:

- If water has not been used for several hours, run the tap until there is a noticeable **temperature drop. Then, run water for 30 seconds to 3 minutes before using it for drinking and cooking.** This helps flush water that may have contained lead that may have leached from plumbing. **Use cold water for cooking, drinking, and preparing baby formula.** Boiling the water will not reduce lead. • **Clean your faucet aerator regularly.**
