Public Hearing #1 – Mansfield City Township Tax Budget
@ 6:40pm

PRESIDENT PHIL SCOTT: It is 6.40am. We'll call this a public hearing on the Mansfield City Township Tax Budget to order and first I'll call on Finance Director Converse for any comments she might have on it.

DIRECTOR KELLY CONVERSE: Okay, thank you. This is a routine practice that we engage in in the middle of the year, basically just to certify our share of the inside millage of property taxes to the county, which gives them an idea of where we're going to start with our budget. They then give us a notification of our share of the inside millage at 92% of what that is. They start out conservative, and then we base our certification to them more on our history of collections. So, we've already received our first payment of real estate taxes this year, and it was 58% of our estimate. So, we're looking at being right on the same pace as we were last year. We don't think that the second payment will be as much because some people make a full year's payment in the first payment, so they aren't equal. But we are tracking right on the same area that we were last year, and still right on par with what the county has certified to us.

PRESIDENT PHIL SCOTT: I guess we really don't have any public here for comment. Carl, you have anything to say? Okay. Seeing no, with only the media in the audience, I guess there's no public to comment. So, with that, what do we got? 6.43, I will close this public hearing on the Mansfield and Township Tax Budget.
